## What to Wear in Greece

The weather in April in Santorini can be cold, windy and rainy but it can also be sunny and warm. You should plan to pack light winter or spring clothes. Trousers, jeans, capris, long dresses, sweaters and jackets will all be appropriate for April. Dressing in layers will help you to adjust your wardrobe as the temperatures change throughout the day/week.

### SUGGESTED DRESS CODE FOR GROUP ACTIVITIES

- *Welcome Reception & Offsite Group Dinner:* We suggest island/European casual
  - Women — maxi dresses, blouses and skirts, nice jeans, wedges, sandals, etc.
  - Men — golf shirts, khaki pants, nice jeans, stylish sneakers, boat shoes, etc.
- *Final Group Dinner:* We suggest country club casual for this evening. We will have a photographer onsite to take your pictures with the Santorini sunset as your backdrop.

### SHOES

The good news about visiting Greece in spring is that you can (probably) bring minimal footwear! The most important pair of shoes for Greece in spring is comfortable but stylish sandals. Think about comfort and traction for walking/exploring the city as well as safely handling the steps at ancient ruins.

### BATHING SUITS

The sea water will be cold (at least for most people) and swimming in the sea might be challenging. The hotel pool is available for guest use. We will also offer our guests a chance to take a dip in the hot springs during our group boating activity on Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>. If you choose to participate, pack an old or dark bathing suit that you don't care about as the water is rich in sulfur and can stain or discolor.
